RULES:

- Exhibitors must have liability insurance.
- Pre-registration must be completed two weeks prior to Fair.
- Enter through Gate #4.
- All entries must be owned and registered in the name to the exhibitor.
- Exhibitors must maintain control of their animals at all times.
- Exhibitors need to supply their own straw for their animals.
- Cattle must be on grounds by 10:00am and must remain on grounds until 5:00pm.
- The maximum total eligible exhibits from a breeding unit are 10 head. For Junior Female Classes, exhibits per breeding unit are restricted to a maximum of 2 exhibits in a maximum of two classes. There is no restriction on multiple exhibits for milking female classes.
- For the purpose of the 2018 Dairy Cattle classification, an entry shall be interpreted as follows: All registered dairy cattle, whether owned by ONE person or by MORE THAN ONE person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm or one breeding unit, are considered to be production of one farm or breeding unit, therefore only ONE entry per class is eligible from such a farm or breeding unit, except as authorized above. Where the same interests are involved in more than one breeding operation, such operations are considered as one breeding unit.
- Space in barn will be on first come first served basis.
- Rosettes will be provided for Junior & Senior female champions.

SECTIONS:

1. Female, Junior Calf – Born Mar 1, 2018 to May 31, 2018.
2. Female, Intermediate Calf – Born Dec 1, 2017 to Feb 28, 2018.
3. Female, Senior Calf – Born Sept 1, 2017 to Nov 30, 2017.
4. Female, Junior Yearling – Born March 1, 2017 to Aug 31, 2017.
5. Female, Senior Yearling – Born Sept 1, 2016 to Feb 28, 2017.
6. Female - In milk, dry or not yet calved for the first time - Born Sept 1, 2015 to Aug 3, 2016 (2 years old).
7. Female - In milk or dry. If dry, must be within approx. 8 weeks of calving - Born Sept 1, 2014 to Aug 31, 2015 (3 years old)
8. Female - In milk or dry. If dry, must be with approx. 8 weeks of calving - Born Sept 1, 2013 to Aug 31, 2014 (4 years old).
9. Female - In milk or dry. If dry, must be within approx. 8 weeks of calving - Born Sept 2, 2012 to Aug 31, 2013 (5 years old).
10. Female - In milk or dry. If dry, must be within approx. 8 weeks of calving - Born prior to Sept 1, 2012 (Mature Cow).

11. Breeder's Herd (bred and owned by exhibitor). Group of three animals. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the classes for single animals. Registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as "Breeder" and as "Owner" in both cases either as an individual or in partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be a joint owner of an animal and/or the joint breeder of an animal. All the animals must be from one farm or breeding unit.
12. Best Udder Class – Judge shall designate best three udders in Classes 7, 8, 9, & 10. These designated exhibits shall compete for first, second and third best udders in the show. Prize money to be paid on first place only.
