This is a Dominion Rabbit and Cavy Breeders' Association sweepstake show. Prizes will be awarded for Best of Breed, Reserve of Breed, Best in Show, and Reserve in Show.

RULES:

- All exhibitors must pay membership fee of \$10.00 to the Orillia & District Agricultural Society in order to exhibit. This will be paid at the gate or with your convenor.
- Exhibitors do not need to members of the Dominion Rabbit and Cavy Association in order to show.
- All general rules and regulations listed on page four in the prize book are applicable, unless overridden below.
- All entries must be made in advance by Monday, September 3, 2018 by e-mail to show convenor at coeeytim@yahoo.ca or by mail to 13 First St, Orillia ON L3V 4A8. No entries or changes on the day of show.
- Payment for entries is made in cash to show convenor on the day of the show. Entry fee of \$3.00 is required per animal.
- Entries to be in place by 8:30am on the day of show and must be left in place until 4:30pm. Judging will begin at 9:30am.
- This will be a carrier cage show; all animals are to be brought in in carriers and then brought up to the judging tables when requested by the show clerk.
- All animals must be healthy. Any animals showing signs of illness will be removed from the show area. Entry fee will not be refunded.
- The judges' decision shall be final. The new revised 2017 D.R. & C.B.A Standard of Perfection shall be the guide therein, and all rabbits and cavies shall be judged by comparison.
- The Orillia and District Agricultural Society will take all precautions to ensure the safety and welfare of all animals, but will not be responsible for loss or damage whatsoever. All animals are shown at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
