

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The ORILLIA & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY (the "Society") complies with the "Personal Information Protection & Electronic Documents Act".

EXHIBITING:

1. All exhibitors must be registered for their event and must be 2019 members.
2. Forms can be found online at www.orilliafallfair.com and are due by Monday September 2nd at 12:00pm. Membership fees must accompany forms.
3. Junior Fair membership fee is \$5.00 and entitles the holder to admission to the Orillia Fall Fair all weekend and entry in any 4H class in which the holder is eligible.
4. Senior Fair membership is \$10.00 and will also entitle a Junior to show in the Senior and Junior Fair, and admission all weekend. Exhibits shown in the Senior Fair are not eligible for entry in Junior Fair.

ANIMAL EXHIBITS:

5. ALL EXHIBITORS OF ANIMALS MUST HAVE LIABILITY INSURANCE. All livestock entries must be free of all contagious disease.
6. The Club Leader may assist in supervising and placing exhibit.
7. No animal shall be shown in more than one class except where specifically mentioned in the prize book and no exhibitor can win more than two prizes in the same section.
8. Exhibitors of Horses, Cattle and Sheep must be ready and present for judging when called to the judging ring or they will NOT be considered.
9. The Orillia School Fair Cattle Show is open to elementary school children of Simcoe and adjoining counties that are not 4H members.
10. All animals must be healthy. Any animals showing signs of illness will be removed from the show area. Entry fee will not be refunded.
11. Exhibitors to supply own straw for animals.
12. Exhibitors must maintain control of their animals at all times.

JUDGING:

13. No unauthorized person is allowed in applicable area during judging. Authorized persons include Chairperson, Judges, assistants and any other person authorized by the Chairperson.
14. Decisions of judges are final and only written appeals with a \$10.00 fee will be considered. The fee will be returned if the appeal is successful.

PRIZE MONEY:

Note: 10% to be deducted from all winners in all senior classes receiving \$10.00 or over. This includes all animal classes.

15. All cash prizes will be mailed as soon as possible and cheques must be cashed before October 31, 2019 or prize money will be forfeited and be considered a donation to the society.
16. In case of bad weather or any unforeseen circumstances, the Society reserves the right to cancel any sections or classes of the Fair as it deems necessary. It is recommended that exhibitors check with either the convenor of their section, the Fair Office or our website to check on the status of their sections of classes.
17. All precautions are taken to safeguard exhibits but exhibitors enter at their own risk. If an exhibit is injured, lost or stolen, the Society will only assist the exhibitor to recover same.
18. The Society and its Directors shall not be responsible for accidents on the grounds or injury to persons, animals, vehicles or other personal property belonging to those entering Fairgrounds. All persons attending the Fair and its events do so at their own risk.
19. The Society will NOT be liable for any loss to any exhibit from fire, accident, structural defect, negligence of other exhibitors or officials.
