## Cut Flowers from your garden

1. 1 Gladiolus - Red, Wine or Mauve
2. 1 Gladiolus - White or Yellow
3. 1 Gladiolus - any colour not listed above
4. 3 Gladiolus - different colours
5. 3 Gladiolus - same colour
6. 1 Dahlia large (over 6")
7. 1 Dahlia medium (3 to $6^{\prime \prime}$ )
8. 1 Dahlia Small (Under 3")
9. 1 Dahlia floating in dish with foliage (any size)
10. Coleus -3 stems, any variety
11. 3 stems Chrysanthemums
12. Geranium - 3 heads, one colour with own foliage
13. Geranium - 3 heads, mixed colours with own foliage
14. Collection of Asters - not to exceed 8 items
15. Marigolds, 5 large blooms over 3 "
16. Marigolds, 5 blooms under $2^{\prime \prime}$ bi-colored
17. 5 stems Petunias - single
18. 5 Blooms Pansies
19. 5 Stems Cosmos
20. Zinnia-3 blooms, decorative
21. Zinnia - 3 blooms, pompon
22. Zinnia - 3 blooms, cactus
23. Collection of Zinnias - not to exceed 5 stems
24. 3 stems of annual, not listed above
25. 3 stems Sedum (may be split into large \& small if entries merit)
26. Collection of Hosta leaves up to $6^{\prime \prime}$ in length suitably arranged, not to exceed 5 stems
27. Collection of Hosta leaves over $6^{\prime \prime}$ in length suitably arranged, not to exceed 5 stems
28. Hydrangea, 3 stems
29. Perennial, 3 stems not listed above
30. 1 Rose Floating with Foliage - any colour
31. 1 Miniature Rose - any colour
32. 1 Hybrid Tea Rose - any colour
33. 1 Rose - not previous listed, named if possible

## Potted Plants

34. African Violet - single, single crown only
35. African Violet - double or semi-double, single crown only
36. House Plant (non-flowering) - should never bloom, named
37. Herb Planter, named
38. Fern - Potted, suited to hang
39. Begonia - 1 potted
40. Geranium -1 potted in bloom.
41. Coleus - 1 variety, must be grown in pot
42. Succulent - Pot not to exceed 4"
43. Succulent - Pot over 4"
44. Mixed pot flowering annual, must be in bloom, not hanging.
45. Cactus - pot not to exceed $10^{\prime \prime}$
46. Most unusual houseplant, named if possible.

Arrangements - accessories permitted
47. By the Roadside - arrangement of plants, flowers, weeds, grasses etc.
48. Awesome Autumn - red, yellow \& orange flowers arranged in a pumpkin, gourd or squash
49. Once Upon a Time - arrangement using an antique article
50. Welcome to My Garden - arrangement of cut flowers from your own garden, in suitable container.
