### **RULES:**

- See Senior Fair rules for entry deadlines, and exhibit placement and removal.
- Samples of materials must be included with entry.
- Exhibits must be work done by exhibitors and not previously entered in Orillia Fall Fair.
- Quilts shown in Section 1 a/b/c (bed size quilts, hand quilted) will be considered for the Grand Champion Hand Quilt. Quilts shown in Section 2 a/b/c (bed size quilts, machine) will be considered for the Grand Champion Machine Quilt. Quilts in sections 3 a/b/c (bed size quilts long arm machine) will also be considered for the Grand Champion Machine Quilt if they are quilted by the exhibitor. Quilts must be a minimum of 324" on the perimeter to be considered for the District Competition.
- For copyright purposes the design must be credited to the owner. Attach name of quilt design and name of pattern designer to the entry.

#### TIPS:

- All articles must be clean, unused and free of all odours, including but not limited to smoke, mothballs, mould, and cigarette smoke. Any article not meeting these criteria will be disqualified and eliminated from the competition prior to judging.
- Quilts must be made using batting (sample to be included).
- Cover your name on the guilt label.
- Use safety pins to attached tags, labels, and samples to your entry.

  - d) Art/Thread Work Quilt ready to hang

  - f) Quilt Block, any technique (unquilted) min 12"
